I would like you spend some time today doing an activity that you know makes you feel happy, or spend some time in your safe, calm place.

Phonics Phase 1, Aspect 5 - Alliteration

We're making lots of silly soup, we're going to make it silly! We're going to put it in the fridge to make it nice and chilly!

I have put in three items that begin with the sound "t": tomatoes, teddy and toast! Can you think of or find three items beginning with a "c" sound?

Thank you to all for engaging with our home learning ideas. The main things to keep doing are reading, talking as much as possible and singing your favourite songs and rhymes.

Numberblocks and Alphablocks are good educational programmes to watch at home to support development. Phonics play is also free currently. In nursery we focus on Phase 1:
