CORE LEARNING TASK FOR ENGLISH

Phonics

- Watch the video on Youtube which focuses on using the sounds we have learnt to read longer words [Lesson 9 - Year 1 - YouTube](#)
- Practise sounding out these words and getting fluent with them - little and often is the key! See if you can write some super sentences with some of these words!

English

LO: To create a poster about an animal based on new information.

- Complete the activities found on 'Day 4' of the attachment titled: Y1-Wk-3-Perfect -Pets.
- Enjoy watching the videos on different animals and pets.
- Choose an animal to write about. Watch the chosen animal video again. Whilst watching, pause and allow your child to write down words/ phrases/ sentences about the information they have heard.
- With these phrases, create an information poster on that animal: include what they eat, where they live and some fun facts.
- Don't forget your full stops, capital letters and finger spaces and to share your writing on Tapestry!

LO: To use the language 'tens and ones' when describing number.

KEY VOCABULARY

ENGLISH - information poster, animals, where do they live? What do they eat? Facts.

MATHS - tens, ones, equal to.

GEOGRAPHY - compass, north, south, east, west, map, directions.

MUSIC - singing, voice, pirates, mice, listen, appraise, happy, sad, loud, quiet.

WIDER CURRICULUM TASK

- GEOGRAPHY ~ LO: To use the vocabulary north, south, east and west.
- The children are to be introduced to the 4 main compass points: north, south, east and west. You can draw these out on a piece of paper. You can either draw and label your own compass, or use the template on Tapestry labelled 'Compass'.
- Complete the activity labelled 'Compass Directions Activity' on Tapestry to get used to using the new vocab OR draw your own map with directions using compass points! Make sure to post these on Tapestry so we can see your amazing work!
