CORE LEANING TASK FOR ENGLISH

<u>Phonics</u>

- Watch the video on Youtube (Lesson 14) which focuses on using the sounds we have learnt to read longer words <u>https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=IMs-</u> <u>WVooOh4&list=PLuGr6z2H2KNHY2HITC9jV0a</u> <u>65ED0aD2Ry&index=48</u>
- Practise sounding out these words and getting fluent with them little and often is the key! See if you can write some super sentences with some of these words!

<u>English</u>

LO: To retell a story both orally and in written format.

- Complete the activities found on 'Day 4' of the attachment titled: Y1-Wk-4-Bunnies.
- Listen one more time to the story 'That Rabbit Belongs to Emily Browne'.
- Can your child remember what the Queen offered Emily in return for Stanley? Talk through the list using some time words e.g. first, then, next etc.
- Ask your children to write a list using time words such as first, next etc.
- OR write their own list of what they would offer if they wanted someone else's toy.

WIDER CURRICULUM TASK

- GEOGRAPHY ~ LO: To describe the common weather of the four seasons of the year.
