CORE LEARNING TASK FOR ENGLISH

LO: To demonstrate understanding of texts by asking and answering who, what, where, when, what, why and how questions

1. Listen to me read or read the pdf of Chapter 7 of 'The Disappearing Moon'.
2. Have a discussion with someone at home about what happened in the chapter.
3. Answer the comprehension questions that focus on pages 42-44

The question types are:

1. Looking (or listening) for a word or phrase in the text. (L)
2. Finding a clue in the text we have read or listened to. (C)
3. Thinking deeper about our opinions in response to the text. (T)

LO: To recap making equal groups by sharing

WIDER CURRICULUM TASKS

PE: To practise throwing, catching and bouncing skills

1. Throw a ball/beanbag underhand in the air and catch it.
2. Throw a ball against the wall and catch it
3. Throw a ball/beanbag at a target, aiming for it to land in the target
4. Throw a ball/beanbag underhand with a partner
5. Practise bouncing the ball with one hand

Top Tip: bounce with fingertips not slapping the ball with the palm of your hands. You can make beanbags by filling a pair of socks with rice!
