LO: To make equal groups with grouping.

Top Tip: Ensure your child has a secure understanding of grouping by asking them to make groups of _ from a certain number of items.

E.g. make groups of 2 grapes from these 20 grapes.

Grouping is an important link to division and helps children see that a whole can be separated into equal groups.
