CORE LEARNING TASK FOR ENGLISH

Phonics

- Continue to practise your speed sounds (found on Youtube or under 'documents' on Tapestry).
- Watch the video on Youtube of a review of the sounds 'or', 'ur' and 'oo': [Lesson 3 - Year 1 - YouTube](#).
- Practise the words containing these sounds; write some words out and try and write a sentence containing one or more of these sounds – I can't wait to read your super sentences!

English

LO: To create a poster based on the main character.

- Complete the activities found on 'Day 4' of the attachment titled: Y1-Wk-2-Highway-Rat.
- Watch the Highway Rat film again – can you guess which foods he is going to steal again?
- Talk about why the Highway Rat is a baddie and a beast. Create a 'WANTED' poster to help catch the Highway Rat. Encourage use of the words from the text, such as: baddie, beast. Challenge your child to include the word 'and' in their writing.
- Don't forget your capital letters, full stops and finger spaces.
- Share your writing on Tapestry!

MUSIC – singing, voice, pirates, listen, appraise, happy, sad, loud, quiet.

WIDER CURRICULUM TASK

- GEOGRAPHY ~ LO: To be able to locate land and sea on a map.
- The children are to look at a wide range of maps (Google Earth, OS maps, maps on electronic devices e.g. iPhones)
- Children are to identify what is land and what is sea.
- Using the map attached to Tapestry ('label the UK'), you can use your knowledge from previous weeks to label the countries in the UK and to colour in the land green and the sea blue.
- Make sure to post these on Tapestry so we can see your amazing work!
- MUSIC ~ LO: To have the opportunity to sing a variety of songs and appraise them.
