CORE LEARNING TASK FOR ENGLISH

LO: To demonstrate understanding of texts by asking and answering who, what, where, when, why, how questions.

Top Tip : The question types are:

1. Looking (or listening) for a word or phrase in the text. (L)
2. Finding a clue in the text we have read or listened to. (C)
3. Thinking deeper about our opinions in response to the text. (T)

LO: To add equal groups

Top Tip :

Adding equal groups is an important step in multiplication as it shows what is happening when you multiply. It helps to use the phrase 'lots of' so 3 groups of 2 can be described as '3 lots of 2', 3×2 or $2+2+2$
