Welcome to Year 1!



The children will then gradually be eased into more formal learning as the year goes on so that they remain motivated, enthused and eager learners.




Your child has been given a reading book and a reading record this week. They have a space to record comments about how your child has read. They should be able to read the book independently sounding out unfamiliar words. Books will be changed if your child has read on a **Monday, Wednesday and Friday**. Please aim to listen to your child read as often as possible.

Homework: The children will be given a half-termly set of activities related to our topic. This will be stuck into your child's homework book at the beginning of each half term with a number of different tasks. Your child may choose to complete them in any order they wish, however please encourage them to complete as many of the tasks as you can. Please feel free to be as creative as you like with presentation.

PE Days: Mondays and Wednesdays. Please make sure your child has the appropriate PE kit in school at all times and that all PE items are named in case anything gets lost. We are looking forward to working with you to ensure your child makes good progress this year and that learning is fun!

Drinks : Please can your child bring in a bottle filled with water each day. Fresh fruit is provided daily but children are free to bring in their own fruit snack if they wish.
