

Topic

Research Project

Our next topic is going to be surrounding Brazil.

Research:

- Where in the world is Brazil?
- What is the weather like in Brazil?
- What is the capital city of Brazil?
- What animals might you find in Brazil?
- What is the life like for someone who lives in Brazil?

You could turn this information into a leaflet or poster to display this information. You could also create a fact file based on an animal that lives in Brazil.

Science

Life Cycle of a Plant

The main stages of a plant are germination, growing and flowering, pollination, fertilisation and seed dispersal. Research the life of a plant and design a way to show this information. For example, a poster, a PowerPoint presentation or any other way you would like.

PSHE

We have been exploring balanced lifestyles and a balanced diet. This is a great opportunity to talk about how we can maintain a balanced lifestyle. You could make some balanced meals together and look at the Eatwell plate together (this can be found online).

English

Children should have the opportunity to have some form of daily writing practice. This could be keeping a diary, writing a story based on an image or a book of their own, writing a book review, a newspaper report or a poem etc. Children could complete some writing linked to their next topic such as writing a story set in Brazil, setting description or creating a poster encouraging people to visit etc.

Maths

Daily - Please practise your times tables. There are a range of games on this website to support your learning:

Daily – Arithmetic worksheet. Please see example worksheet showing some calculations that are appropriate for Year 3. Children should be focusing on adding and subtracting numbers with up to 3-digits and multiplying and dividing 2 digits by a 1 digit number.
