Write out the recipe; make it if you can and take pictures of it being enjoyed by your family.</p>	<p>Can you create your own model of a favela out of recyclable materials?</p>	<p>Create a Brazilian glossary (book design of your choice) listing and explaining a minimum of 15 words. How best can you present your words - colour, drawings, alphabetised</p>
<p>Imagine you are living in the Favelas. Write a diary about your day. Really put yourself in their shoes and focus on your feelings about what you see and your circumstances.</p>	<p>Keep a weather diary/complete a weather chart for a week for the weather at home and use the internet to chart the weather in Brazil. Show your findings in a suitable way - graph maybe. What are your main findings?</p>	<p>Create a map of a rainforest overlaid with a grid. Remember to label your x and y axis on your grid with a, b, c, d 1, 2, 3, 4 Create a set of instructions (start here, move forward 1, turn right etc.) to guide a friend to the goal</p>	<p>Combine the features of two animals from the rainforest to create your own new animal. Make a fictional fact file for it. What name would you give it? Which features did you choose and why?</p>
<p>Find out about a tribe who live in the Rainforest. - Where do they live? - Do they have houses? - What do they eat? - How do they get their food? - What do they wear? - What language do they speak? - Do children attend school?</p>	<p>Design and make a rainforest model. What could you use from our natural/man-made environment? Think about the plant layers e.g. shrub layer, under canopy</p>	<p>Compose and perform a rainforest dance/music (perhaps with a friend/s). What music/sounds would fit with the rainforest theme? What movements could you do?</p>	<p>Write an imaginative story about the life of a child surviving in the rainforest. How did they get there? Where will they end up? What will they see? Who or what might they be afraid of?</p>
<p>An area of rainforest the size of a football field is being destroyed each second. Create a poster or a leaflet to persuade people to help protect the Rainforest. Think about: - Why are they cutting down the rainforests? - Who is doing this? - Who does it affect? - What can we do to help?</p>	<p>Find out about products which come from the Rainforest. - Identify what they are used for and who uses them. - Which of these products do you use in your home? - How far have these products had to travel for you to use them? Present your findings on a fact sheet.</p>	<p>Choose an animal which lives in the rainforest and write an interesting fact file about your chosen animal!</p>	<p>Compare your life to a child who lives in the rainforest,</p>
